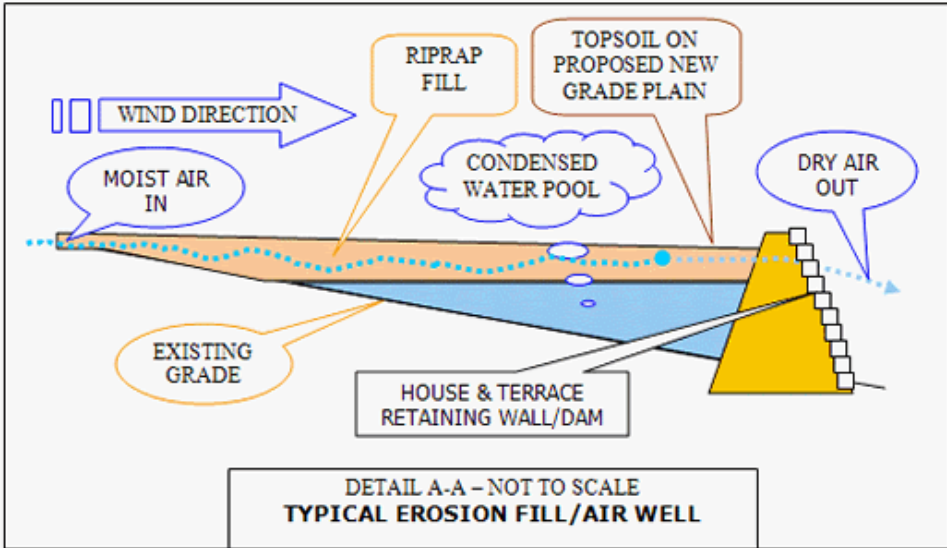
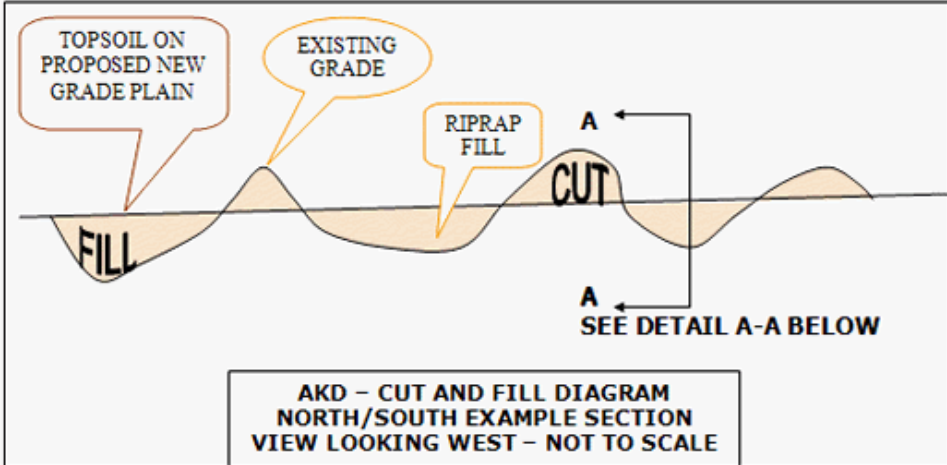


POOLS OF WATER IN THE DESERT

The Perimeter of AKD

The BELTWAY is a RETAINING WALL a little more than 39 miles long i.e. 63.5 Kilometers, and in some places it is more than 300 feet high, surrounding AKD. This wall makes it possible to clear the area, cut all the hills, and fill in all the valleys, to make A PLAIN within the BELTWAY.

“Your WARFAIR is past”

“Your INIQUITY is past”

“Your PENALTY is paid”

Can we make these DECLARATIONS NOW?

For 1000 years, from the time of Saul/David/Solomon to the time of Jesus and his disciples, Israel was a functioning kingdom. In 7 years 66-73AD this kingdom was total dissolved as punishment for her many sins.

Double this time, 1,000 YEARS, and you have the time from Jesus to today, 2,000 years. What does this mean?

“THE DEBT IS PAID!”

The gates to freedom are open! What do we do now? Freedom is hopelessness, confusion, and degradation if we have no OBJECTIVE. So, we are free, what now?

“Make a straight Highway
Fill every Valley
Cut every Hill”

“PREPARE YE THE WAY OF YHWH”

Why – What will this accomplish?

“The glory of YHWH shall be revealed
All flesh shall see it together.”

This is what Israel lost in her sins, THE GLORY OF YHWH. Can she get back THE GLORY OF YHWH?

YES!

This is such a great DECLARATION that the Spirit of YHWH is prompting me to make. Can we understand what this means?

“For the mouth of YHWH has spoken it.” Isaiah 40:3-5

Do you understand what this means?

We have been so long prisoners of war and warfare. Can this be real? Is our warfare accomplished? Is our iniquity really pardoned? What do we do now? How do we proceed? What actions do we take?

This famous 40th chapter of Isaiah ends with these words:

vs. 31. *“They that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.”*

For 2,000 years our forefathers have endured all sorts of extreme hardships to make it possible for us to ride in air conditioned cars and fly in aircraft around the world. But are we, this generation, really ready to “wait upon the LORD”? If we are we will carry out His Instructions.

“Prepare the WAY of THE LORD, Make a straight Highway, Fill every Valley, Cut every Hill”

These are the terms of our parole. These are the things we must do to “COMFORT MY PEOPLE AND JERUSALEM.”

Retaining wall

A site development engineer would refer to the leveling and contouring of the land upon which something is to be built as CUT AND FILL: cut the high places and fill the low.

“The land shall be turned to a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem.” Zechariah 14:10a

The area described by Ezekiel is now badly scared by erosion. Often an engineer, when called to correct this problem, will design a RETAINING WALL to extending across a ravine or valley, and then fill in behind the wall.

A Kingdom District (AKD) has a 40 mile parameter. This is located around Jerusalem. The land around the parameter undulates through eroded valleys and over rocky ridges, especially on the eastern side.

What we must do is to build a RETAINING WALL all around this site. This wall will be set to the average height/depth of the undulations. Then the ridges inside the BELTWAY will be cut to provide fill behind the wall. This will accomplish several things besides the obvious, a way for a STRAIGHT and level HIGHWAY and WALKING PATH.

One, THE WALL will provide space for utilities, transportation, homes and gardens. These will be designed into the face of THE WALL. This space will provide housing and guest accommodations with garden terraces and wonderful views of the Dead and Mediterranean Seas.

Two, THE WALL will act as a dam, retaining precious rain water in these high elevations and preventing erosion below; as well as providing irrigation for terraces all the way to the sea below. (See pg. 78)

Three, THE WALL will retain the rubble from the ridges. This rubble will have space for air and water which will accommodate another phenomenon called AIR WELLS.

Four, the AIR WELLS will produce water from the air much as a cloud does, except underground. When warm moist air is cooled underground to what is called the Due Point, water will condense on the rough edges of the rocks and precipitate out into a pool below.

Condensation occurs in a cloud when microscopic particles of dust are present. When the air rises it is subsequently cooled to the due point, and water droplets form around the particles in the air and then fall to the ground. In an AIR WELL the water in the air is cooled by the earth to the due point causing water to form on the rough edges of brick or stone. As we said, this moisture then runs off and is stored in a pool below.

Chapter 9 — BELTWAY

It is conceivable that the proposed site could capture the prevailing warm moist air from the Western Sea, and direct it under ground through the porous fill behind the retaining walls and out through the eastern wall. Within the rubble the ground cooling effect would cool the air providing water and natural cooling to the homes below. This design will incorporate scopes that will ketch some of the warm moist air coming off the Mediterranean, and force it through the rubble and draw it out the eastern wall via convection. In the rubble it will cool to the dew point and condense to add water to the water collected from rain and irrigation runoff.

Via this method (See Diagram Pg. 78), and a method we discuss in Chapter 11, this project will produce THE RIVER Ezekiel describes.

“[A]nd it was a river that I could not pass over: . . . at the bank of the river were very many trees on the one side and on the other. . . because their waters th[at] issued out of the sanctuary: and the fruit thereof shall be for meat, and the leaf thereof for medicine.” (Ezekiel 47:2-12 KJV)

There are a number of obvious reasons to want to preserve and conserve water. We have many domestic needs for water. Plants and animals have need for water. Rapid water run off destroys fish habitat and the water shed quickly dries out. Including and providing for all these needs for water is understood. Therefore, let us turn our attention to some less obvious considerations.

Scientists for a number of years have been warning us of the danger of “Global Warning”. High level conferences are being held to discuss what we should and can do to halt this process.

One important benefit derived from making an oasis out of a wasted and barren site such as the one in question is COOLING. The environment is cooled through evaporation and transpiration; more moisture and vegetation leads to more evaporation and transpiration; therefore more cooling.
